PROCESS ART...

 Focuses on the act of working with art supplies, more so than the production of a specific piece.

 Allows kids to be successful because there is no anticipated product.

Often employs sensory components.

MY TYPICAL PROGRAM . . . Starts with a story or book wander with the whole group.

Then demonstration of the media/technique we'll be using.

Then they get to do it!

CONSIDERATIONS - TIMING Preschoolers will usually be done in less than 30 minutes.

School age can often take an hour or more.

CONSIDERATIONS - FAMILY

 Encourage parents to let the child do it their way.

 How to handle younger/older siblings; parents who want to do it too.


